## Re: Fieldwork skills requirement for GCSE Geography (Walton-on-the-Naze, Essex)

As you may be aware, students are required by the new 9-1 Geography GCSE courses to undertake two contrasting fieldwork experiences. In order to meet this compulsory requirement, we have arranged to study a coastal environment during the second half of the summer term and plan an urban environment study later the in the Autumn term. The skills gained are now assessed within the 01 & 02 examination papers rather than through a piece of coursework/ controlled assessment.

It is important that students have the opportunity to be immersed in the fieldwork processes so they are fully prepared for their examinations at the end of Year 11. The work will directly relate to the units of study from the specification, therefore further enhancing their understanding of what has been learnt in class.

Owing to the large numbers of students taking the subject the coastal trips will run over three days. Please make sure your son/daughter is clear about which day they will be attending the trip before completing the return slip.

If this is the case, please notify the Geography Department immediately via their class teacher either in writing or by emailing them (initial & surname)@bestacademies.org.uk The coach, minibus & staffing is at capacity for all days, to keep costs at a minimum, so any changes will have on a knock on effect. We will, however, endeavour to ensure any genuine needs to alter a date are met wherever possible.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution towards the cost of the trip of £14.50 per student to cover transport, insurance and necessary resources. We will depart school at 8:20am and return at approximately 6:30pm, traffic dependent, so arrangements will need to be made for students to be collected. Students are not required to wear the Academy uniform (but must be appropriately dressed for fieldwork in a public place) and they can either bring a packed lunch or, if preferred, money for lunch as they will have time and access to food outlets within Walton.
