Damage to Academy Property Policy (2018)

Rationale and Aim

This policy applies to all pupils/students who attend academies within Bedfordshire East Schools Trust (BEST) and should be referred to in the event of any damage to academy property.

Policy

Any pupil/student who causes damage, or is suspected of causing damage, to academy property will be referred to the appropriate pastoral year team (in lower schools this may be the class teacher). The pastoral team will carry out an investigation and using the BEST Behaviour Policy will impose any sanctions deemed appropriate. This will also involve, if appropriate, debt recovery.
