KS5 Curriculum Sequencing – Homework/Prep Time Work and Private Study Work: Textiles

A Level Textiles homework, prep time work and private study work policy

All homework, prep time work and private study work in A Level Fine Art is set on Edulink homework with a clear set date, due date and time allocation in order to meet the recommended Sixth Form requirement of 8-9 hours of homework/prep time work and/or private study work for the course across each fortnight. Homework or targets for developing coursework set individually are set each week

Homework	6 hours of homework will be set for each student every week. This is class or individually set with one to one feedback given in one to one tutorials in each lesson. Students will then write up their feedback and any targets for progression on their feedback sheet.
Prep time work	3 hours of prep time work will be set for A Level Textiles per fortnight. Prep time work is linked to prepping for future lesson content or continuing work or completing work set in lesson. Prep time work will be checked for progress in future lessons with feedback given in one to one tutorials in each lesson. Students will then write up their feedback and any targets for progression on their feedback sheet.
Private study work	Students will be asked to read around subjects and research areas and artists that link to their chosen focus.
