

## SIXTH FORM ON CALL BISCUIT/CHOCOLATE HOURS

The Sixth Form on call biscuit/chocolate hour takes place when Mr Huckle (Associate Principal – Head of Sixth Form) is on SLT on call. Mr Huckle will pop in to year 12 and 13 classrooms to offer praise. Please see below for the process.

## STEPS TO FOLLOW

- 1. Mr Huckle will enter a Sixth Form lesson where the teacher will be asked to identify one or two students who have shown excellent attitude to learning, independent learning, progress and/or attainment over the last two weeks.
- 2. The student/s will be offered a biscuit or chocolate bar as praise for this achievement
- 3. If the student has allergies, Mr Huckle will sort out an alternative the student/s can collect from the Sixth Form

## **EXAMPLE REASONS THE TEACHER CAN SELECT A STUDENT FROM THE CLASS**

- Achieved an assessment grade above their target grade.
- Achieved an assessment grade in line with their target grade.
- Achieved an assessment grade that shows improvement when compared to the previous grade.
- Excellent attitude to learning and contribution in class across the last fortnight.
- Excellent independent learning evidenced during the last fortnight.
- Any other reason that warrants this praise.
