

Sixth Form Attendance Interventions and Sanctions

An attendance check will be conducted by the Pastoral and Academic Support Officer (PASO) **every two weeks**. The Sixth Form requires a student to be in school as a full-time student, and this means a minimum average attendance of 95%. If at an attendance checkpoint you have unauthorised absence marks interventions from the Sixth Form Team and Tutor will be actioned. There is a clear link between attendance and progress and we need to ensure students are giving themselves the best chance to succeed, and also prepare them for the rules and regulations of any work place.

Truancy call will be used on a daily basis where unauthorised absence is recorded in the morning. This requires a response from parents/carers.
