# **Subject Taster Sessions Wednesday 29th and Thursday 30th June**

## Wednesday 29th June - Out of Catchment Feeder Schools

We will be inviting all year 8 students out of catchment to attend SWA for a series of subject taster sessions from 9:30am till 2:45pm. This will give students the opportunity to meet members of staff and experience lessons at SWA. They will also have an assembly with the year 9 team at the start and end of the day. Students will be required to wear their current school uniform and will need to bring stationary/ a pencil case as well as a snack and packed lunch with them for the day. Students will not be required to have their PE kit.

- Students who currently attend Henlow Academy and Etonbury will be collected via bus from their current school site at 9am.
- Students from all other schools will be required to arrange their own transport to Samuel Whitbread Academy in the morning and students will need to arrive on school site before 9:30am where they will be met by members of staff at the front reception gates.

All year 8 students will then be able to use the Samuel Whitbread buses in order to get home from 2:45pm, or students will be able to walk home. If you need to collect by car, please collect from the road outside the school rather than coming onto the school site.

There will be a selection of icebreaker and team building activities for them to participate in as well as an assembly with the Head of Year and Principal. Students will be required to wear their current school uniform and will need to bring some stationary and/or a pencil case as well as a snack and packed lunch with them for the day. We will be asking students to make their own way to and from Samuel Whitbread Academy for that day and year 8 students will be able to access their SWA transport (buses) for this day.
