TUTOR GROUP ALLOCATION

Dear Parents / Carers.

I am writing to inform you of your child's form tutor and house for their time here at Samuel Whitbread Academy. Their form tutor will be your first point of contact whilst they are with us from September 2023.

See Tutor Group Information emailed to all parents on Friday 16th June 2023.

Tutor groups are allocated to students through a lengthy and comprehensive process of communication with student's current schools. When allocating tutor groupings to students, the academy must consider the needs of each pupil in terms of SEND provision, their language options and choices, and any other additional information provided to us from their current school. It is for all of these reasons that tutor groups are not formed on the basis of current friendship groups. It is also not possible to arrange tutor groups on the basis of student's preferences over the need to ensure that every pupil has the opportunity for a fresh start. It is worth noting that every Year 9 pupil will be new to Samuel Whitbread – and transition week, our taster sessions, and induction to our community supports pupils in forging new friendship groups for a successful learning career at the academy.

Your child has also been allocated a house which they are a part of for their time at Samuel Whitbread Academy. The houses at Samuel Whitbread play an active part of the academy and in the community – and are a chance for students across year groups to come together to take part in department competitions, house quizzes, assemblies, gaining praise points to add to the total and much more. Students wear their house colours on their school blazer, which can be purchased from our uniform provider Total Clothing. All Year 9 students for September 2023 wear a Royal Blue tie. Our uniform policy can be found on our website and in our previous communication including the Transition Handbook.

Our uniform supplier, Total Clothing, will be available on the evening of Monday 3rd July **ONLY**. They will be in attendance to support with uniform sizing queries. You will **not be able to place an order** at this event, as it is for the purposes of trying on our uniform sizes. To order a uniform, you will need to use the following link to the Total Clothing shop: <u>Total Clothing Shop SWA</u>. As **Total Clothing are NOT** available at **SWA** on **Tuesday 4**th **July**, we will permit any parents who wish to visit their stall for sizing to come to the academy on Monday 3rd July, however the timetable above for all of the other events remains in place. It is recommended you place a uniform order before **Thursday I 0**th **August** to ensure that your child joins the academy in the correct uniform. For more information on uniform, please see the separate attached document from our uniform provider to support you.

Outside of the timings above, you are free to explore the uniform sizing stalls on Monday 3rd July, as well as information about school transport, and sample food from our canteen free of charge. Our school transport manager, Mr Whittle, will be in attendance to answer any questions you may have. **To this end, you are welcome to be onsite at SWA no earlier than 5.30pm and no later than 8pm.**



TRANSITION TASTER DAYS: TRANSPORT

<u>Subject Taster Sessions</u> Wednesday 5th July and Thursday 6th July

Wednesday 5th July - Out of Catchment Feeder Schools

We will be inviting all year 8 students <u>out of catchment</u> to attend SWA for a series of subject taster sessions from 8:45am until 3:00pm. This will give students the opportunity to meet members of staff and experience lessons at SWA. They will also have an assembly with the Year 9 team. Students will be required to wear their current school uniform and will need to bring stationary/ a pencil case as well as a snack and packed lunch with them for the day. Students will <u>not</u> be required to have their PE kit.

- Students will be required to arrange their own transport to Samuel Whitbread Academy in the morning and students will need to arrive on school site before 8:45am.
- Students will be given a free bus pass to use on the Samuel Whitbread buses in order to get home from 3:00pm, or students will be able to walk home. If you need to collect by car, please collect from the road outside the school rather than coming onto the school site.

Thursday 6th July 2023 – RBA Students Only

We will be inviting **RBA** students to come for a day of subject sessions from 8:45am until 3:00pm. This will give students the opportunity to meet members of staff and experience lessons at SWA. They will also have an assembly with the Year 9 team. Students will be required to wear their current school uniform and will need to bring stationary/ a pencil case as well as a snack and packed lunch with them for the day. Students will **not** be required to have their **PE** kit.

RBA students will be able to use any of the Samuel Whitbread buses to and from SWA and will be given a free bus pass to use these buses. Alternatively, students will be able to walk home, or dropped off and collected by car if possible. Please drop off and collect students from the road outside.

TRANSITION DAY: ALL STUDENTS

Tutor Transition Day (All Schools) Friday 14th July 2023

We invite all Year 8 students joining us in September from 8:45am to 3:00pm to spend the day with their new tutor and tutor group, allowing them to get to know their new set of peers. There will be a selection of icebreaker and team building activities for them to participate in as well as an assembly with the Head of Year and Principal.

Students will be required to wear their current school uniform and will need to bring some stationary and/or a pencil case as well as a snack and packed lunch with them for the day. Alternatively, our school canteen will accept cash from Year 8 students on this day. **Students will need their current school's**PE kit with them for this day as they will be changing into them and taking part in field sports. Please also ensure that students have a water bottle, a hat and sun screen with them as protection.

Students will need to make their own way to and from Samuel Whitbread Academy for that day and all Year 8 students will be able to access the SWA bus routes for this day. They will have travelled home on this bus on their taster days if they required it. We will be using the same permissions that have been given by you for previous days which indicate how students will travel.

Please make sure that all students know which bus they need to catch, at what time and from which bus stop. The <u>Summary of Bus Routes</u> will indicate which route number covers your area.
