How to measure your child for school uniform...

Uniform Standards

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

ALL boys will require football boots and girls may need to have these for football and hockey. An expensive pair is not necessary and can be purchased from a retailer of your choice. All P.E. kit must be suitably marked with the students' initials and full surnames.

- All stud earrings should be removed before lessons.
 - · Long hair should be tied back.
 - · Leggings are NOT permitted for PE.

All students are expected to participate fully in P.E. lessons. There may be occasions, however, when students are physically incapable of participating. Where this is the case a letter from the parent or carer should be submitted to the class teacher requesting permission for the student to be excused from activity.

Where non-participation is likely to be extended over a period of more than two weeks a medical certificate is required. Non-participants should still be involved in the lesson either by coaching, umpiring, helping with equipment or by working on appropriate work sheets.

Students will, therefore, still need to bring their kit.

JEWELLERY / PIERCINGS

Earrings should be limited to one pair of small stud earrings. Any item of jewellery that a student may wish to wear for religious or cultural importance may be allowed if parents contact the relevant year team to request permission. Such an item may then be worn with the Academy's knowledge and permission. There should be no visible facial or body piercings.

MAKE-UP

A small amount of make-up is acceptable but students should not abuse this privilege.

HAIR

Hair colour should be a 'natural' colour and styles should not be too extreme or 'attention grabbing' e.g. large stripes of colour or shaved patterns. Students should not adorn their hair with excessive accessories.



GENERAL

- We advise that all clothing is clearly marked with the student's name.
- Boots can be worn in extreme winter weather, but students must bring a change of shoe once on-site.
 - Hats/caps may only be worn for prolonged periods outside the buildings in extremes of cold or sun.
 - 'Hoodies' should not be worn.
 - Extremes of fashion must be avoided. A student appearing at the Academy dressed unacceptably may be sent home to change.

General Uniform & PE Kit

Blazer: Plain black with SWA House logo (girls and boys available)

Shirt/Blouse: Plain white with long or short sleeves (shirts/blouses must have a top button to ensure the garment is suitable to wear with a clip on tie)

Tie: Royal Blue tie with SWA Logo

Trousers: Black, tailored with SWA logo (variety of styles available)

Skirt: Black, with SWA logo on hem (variety of styles available)

Jumper: Plain black soft knit v-neck jumper

Shoes: Shoes should be formal and black - not trainers, boots, high heels or canvas shoes. They must cover both the toes and the heels.

Socks/Tights: White, black or grey socks / flesh tone or black tights

Coat: Dark and functional

Belt: Dark colour and functional



Our top uniform buying tips...



House Colours

Make sure you know your child's HOUSE, as you will need this to choose the correct colour logos for blazers.



Boys Trousers

These fit true to size and have an adjustable waist.



Blazers

You may want to go for a slightly bigger blazer size if your child will be wearing a jumper during the winter months. Make sure when you try on your blazer the sleeves come down to the knuckles to allow for growth and across the shoulders there is also room for growth.



Jumpers

The v-neck knitted jumpers can come up fairly small in size. It would be advisable to order a size larger.



Skirts

Remember to fit to just below the knee to allow for growth. Straight skirts sit on the waist and pleated skirts sit just below the waist.



PE Tops

PE Tops should always be bought slightly bigger to allow for growth and ease of taking on and off in a hurry when changing.



Girls Trousers

These fit just below the waist and are a generous fit. There is no adjustable waist.
